Theatre and Human Rights

PHR teamed up with the American Repertory Theatre in Cambridge and the Carr Foundation late this year for a production of *The Children of Herakles*, a modern staging of a 2,400 year old play by Euripides. The play describes the plight of a persecuted family, driven from city state to city state in ancient Greece, pursued by a ruthless tyrant. In the hands of acclaimed director Peter Sellars, the play became a fascinating forum to examine the issues facing present day refugees. PHR played a key role in planning refugee discussions surrounding the play.

"We were at our last gasp, till we found these friends and relatives. Alone of all the Greeks, they've dared to stand up and defend our rights."

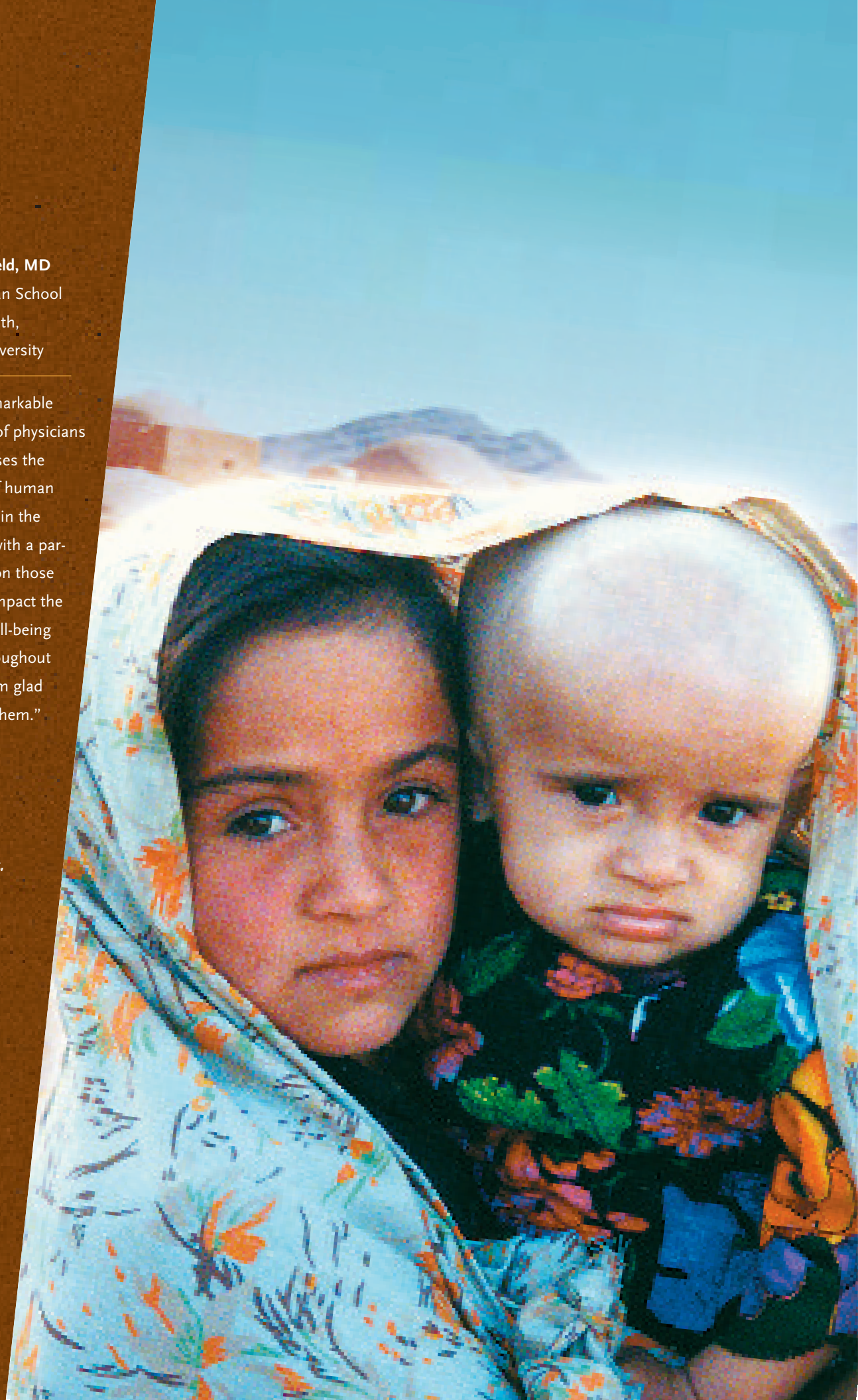
